**PROPOSED DECISION**

To agree to the payment for overtime working of Environmental Health and Trading Standards Officers who are paid above SCP35.

**REPORT**

The Department has found it necessary to require Environmental Health Officers and Trading Standards Officers above SCP35 to incur overtime working in connection with their duties in terms of both the Environmental Protection Act, 1990, the Food Safety Act, 1990 and the Weights and Measures Act, 1985.

The statutory duties involved include collection of evidence with regard to noise and food complaints, trading standards complaints and the monitoring of food premises outwith normal working hours.

It is forecast that this overtime will also be necessary over the next six months and the permission of the Committee is requested to allow these duties to continue to be undertaken.

**RECOMMENDATION**

That the previous overtime undertaken by Environmental Health and Trading Standards Officers involved in statutory duties be approved and also that permission be given for the work to continue when required over the succeeding six months.
