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PROPOSED DECISION

To agree to the recommendation contained in the report.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Extended occupation of the above site is required by the Council until the outstanding restoration works are completed.

A sum of £6,000 has been allocated and approved from revenue monies in the next Financial Year 1999/2000. A sum of £3,000 will also be required from revenue monies from the following Financial Year 2000/2001 due to the proposal from the Director of Finance that the estimated capital amount identified for the works by our consultants of £550,000 plus VAT being allocated over a two year period.

BACKGROUND

Hope Park Landfill Site was the main waste disposal facility for Cumbernauld and Kilsyth District Council for the period 1975 to 1992. An extension area was developed for Landfilling from 1992 to 1994. The site is owned by Viscount Whitelaw, Gartshore Estate and leased to the Council.

The supplementary minute of agreement is required to allow the Council occupation until the necessary remedial restoration works are carried out to the satisfaction of the Planning Department and the regulators of the site, The Scottish Environment Protection Agency.

RECOMMENDATION

To approve the Council entering into the supplementary minute of agreement for the lease of the ground for a further year and arrange for the Head of Legal Services to proceed with the signing of the said agreement.
