1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise Committee of the action taken by the Executive Director of Corporate Service in consultation with the Convenor in appointing Centre Great 1991 Ltd to carry out the 'Street Lighting Contract – Lighting Capital Contract 2 (2007)'.

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 Locations: Woodside Street, Coatbridge
Kildrum Road, Cumbernauld
Cumbernauld Road, Muirhead
Greenacres Area Ph1, Motherwell
Old Edinburgh Road Ph1, Uddingston
Chryston Road, Chryston
All North Lanarkshire

2.2 The works comprise the replacement of street lighting apparatus within the above areas.

2.3 The tender documents were issued to six contractors of whom five submitted tenders as follows:

2.4 The tender of £385,010.02 submitted by Centre Great 1991 Ltd has been consistently and competitively priced and is worthy of consideration for acceptance. Funding for this project is included in the department's approved capital programme under the heading of Street Lighting Refurbishment Programme.

Total	£423,511.02


2.6 Entry to all sites is available.
