1. Purpose of Report

Members are advised that a petition containing approximately 197 signatures has been lodged by local residents of Holytown complaining about the condition of the play park at Dornoch Road, Holytown, and requesting that the Council give consideration to implementing a programme of maintenance works.

2. Background

- 2.1. The petition was lodged with the Executive Director of Corporate Services on 10 July 2014.
- 2.2. In terms of the policy agreed by the Council for dealing with petitions, adopted by the Council on 22 May 1997, the Executive Director of Regeneration and Environmental Services will report further to the Committee on this matter.
