1. Purpose of Report / Introduction

The purpose of this report is to advise Committee of a petition received from residents of an area of Rochsoles, Airdrie requesting an area of open plan ground adjacent to their houses be upgraded by way of the creation and installation of a car park.

2. Background

2.1. The tenants and residents who live in this area are asking that Housing and Social Work Services undertake improvement work to this open space to alleviate parking difficulties at this location.

3. Considerations

3.1. Officers from Airdrie First Stop Shop are currently discussing the request for the creation of a car park with a number of partner agencies and other council services due to the fact that any decision to commit resources to the area would be one that would need to be taken collectively. Tenants and Residents have been advised of this and whenever a decision is taken an update will be given to the petitioners.
