**1. Purpose of Report**

- 1.1 This report seeks to update the Local Area Partnership and Area Committee on progress with the Local Development Programme for 2012/2013.

**2. Background**

- 2.1 The Partnership will recall at the Local Area Partnership meeting held in July 2011 that a list of projects was approved for progression over a two year period during the 2011/2012 and 2012/2013 financial years.

**3. Criteria for Local Development Programme**

- 3.1 To be eligible for inclusion in the Local Development Programme, projects must subscribe to previously agreed criteria. The following are examples of some of the criteria:

- Be linked to the work of the Local Area Teams
- Be publicly visible and accessible
- Come from community groups or individuals
- Improve community safety
- Benefit a large number of people
- Improve the appearance of an area
- Maximise the use of alternative sources of funding

**4. Projects 2012/2013 – 2013/2014**

- 4.1 Progress with individual projects including Estate Based Initiatives for 2012/2013 is shown at **Appendix 1** below. The approved programme for 2013/14 is shown at **Appendix 2**. The 'Holding List' of projects for the area is included at **Appendix 3**.


**5. Corporate Considerations**
