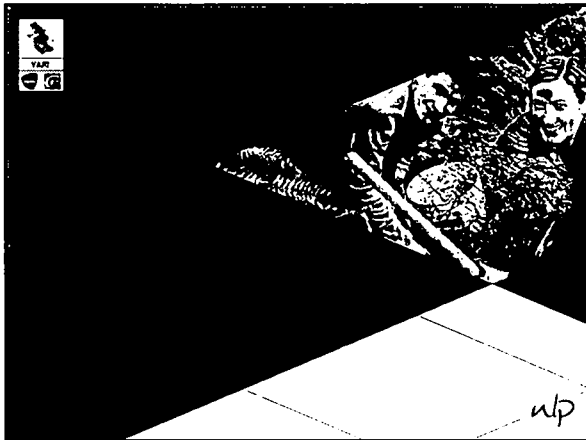

- Key investors in the local sector include North Lanarkshire Council, Scottish Government, Big Lottery Fund, Voluntary Action Fund and several private trust funds

Change Plan Contribution


- Voluntary sector is one of four key partners to sign off local Change Plan
- Devolved budget of 20% for Community Capacity Building and Carer Support

- Voice of Experience Forum leads on local voluntary sector coordination via NL Locality Partnership Development Programme and hosts local consortium
