21. There was submitted a report (docketed) dated 22 May 2002 by the Chief Executive (1) intimating that the forthcoming Local Government (Scotland) Act will establish, inter alia, a statutory duty for local authorities and other key bodies who actively engage with communities to promote and plan for the wellbeing of their area; (2) advising that the North Lanarkshire Partnership had produced a framework through which the wellbeing of the North Lanarkshire area could be monitored over time; (3) advising that area profiles for each of the Area Committee areas had been prepared, which contain a range of statistical information covering the themes of (a) population and household; (b) employment and unemployment; (c) benefits receipt; (d) learning, (e) housing; (f) land use; (g) health; (h) community safety, and (l) local perceptions from the resident survey; (4) advising that the Local Area Plans should influence policy by forming an input into the annual budgetary review and service planning process of the Council and the community planning partners; (5) containing proposals to develop effective Area Plans on a staged basis, by identifying issues emerging from the statistical profiles, relating these in the first instance to Council service provision, and then utilising this information as a tool to stimulate contributions to discussions on these issues at a local area, and (6) containing details of the various approaches which may be used to aid participation.

Decided:

- (1) that the development of a Local Area Plan for the North Area Committee area be agreed;
- (2) that the completion of the initial North Area Profile be noted;
- (3) that the piloting of community participation on a staged basis be supported, and
- (4) that the report be otherwise noted.

REMIT FROM COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMITTEE HELD ON 15 MAY 2002 - PROVISION OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCES WITHIN NORTH LANARKSHIRE

24. With reference to paragraph 3 of the Minute of the meeting of the Community Services Committee held on 15 May 2002, there was submitted a report dated 9 April 2002 by the Director of Community Services (1) advising Members of the increasing number of comments received concerning the closure of a number of public conveniences across North Lanarkshire; (2) highlighting a trend throughout the country by local authorities to reduce the provision of public conveniences as a result of budget saving requirements and an increase in cost of running such facilities due to vandalism and other anti-social behaviour, including drug abuse; (3) detailing those public conveniences that had been closed by the Council as part of its 2000/2002 efficiency saving; (4) giving details of the level of savings as a result of these closures; (5) identifying other community services facilities which could be used for public convenience provision; (6) highlighting the potential difficulties in providing this alternative service to the public, and (7) proposing that access should continue to be permitted within Sports Centres and library facilities for use as public conveniences and that the Department should accelerate the current negotiations with the suppliers of automatic toilets across the authority with a view to increasing these throughout North Lanarkshire.
