**Police Report**



**Police Report**

Since the last meeting the Police have been promoting the 'Safer Scotland' initiative which concentrates on street disorder and street drinking. This has resulted in 7 people being reported to the Procurator Fiscal during the month of November.

**Report to Procurator Fiscal**

5 persons reported for street drinking.

2 persons reported for breach of the peace.

Also during November one person was reported to Procurator Fiscal for drink driving.

From Monday 6th December 04 until 5th January 05 police will be promoting their Festive Road Safety Campaign which targets drink and drug drivers. This will involve additional vehicle stops and driver breath tests being carried out.
