(This has been refused but the Nursery are appealing it) The following is a summary of issues raised from the floor</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A/ Concerns over Traffic increase B/ Lack of privacy for near by houses C/ Staff smoking in Car park D/ Lack of Nursery provision in Cumbernauld E/ Lack of suitable hours in available nurseries F/ Community Council showing favouritism towards nursery by using it as a venue <p>The Community Council agreed that despite their best efforts, enough notice had not been given for a vote on whether to support nursery appeal or not. Therefore the vote was abandoned. It will not be rescheduled due to the timescale.</p> <p>The Community Council also stated that there had never been any favouritism shown towards the Nursery and its plans at any time.
