Community Service event is anticipated on March 12 2005 from 10am an all day event in the Pivot Centre. More details to follow later.





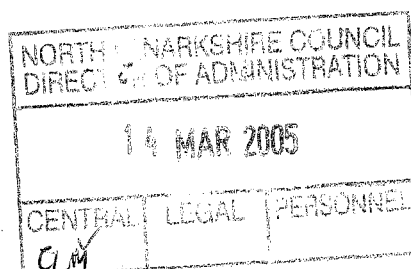
