Police Matters

There have been problems in the village over the past few weeks with cars being smashed and groups of vigilantes from other towns using Queenzieburn as their battleground. Calls have been made on several occasions to the police, however there has been little to no response. Letter will be sent to the Chief Inspector asking for a full report and why there has been no response to emergency calls. Further calls need to be logged.

Cleansing & Parks

There was a meeting with the parks department, the trees at the back of Dumbreck Terrace will be cut back as well as other areas throughout the village. Unsafe paths were found due to the hedge being over grown on Kilsyth Road near the main stairs, as well as Meadowside Road near the bing, there is also an unsafe garage at this area which is collapsing and becoming a hazard. The woods area will also be cleaned up with broken bottles etc lifted and bushes cut back.

Bon Fire

Approval of public liability insurance has come through for the bon fire and fireworks display. Chapelgreen Primary School has been contacted and they will make the guy for the event. Lidil have agreed to donate sweets to us rather than fire works. Volunteers will give out the sweets for free to children at the event. Volunteers will also go around with buckets to collect donations at the event.

There is a new lottery fund for large-scale projects to build a living landmark in your community. Possibilities are upgrading the community centre and showers, floodlighting the park and back park etc. Lottery will be contacted asking to give us a presentation of funding available.
