Issues Raised

Carrickstone Hospital

NHS Lanarkshire has agreed revised contract arrangements with Carrickstone Care Home to ensure that older people in Cumbernauld continue to receive high quality care in the most appropriate place.

The forum thinks this is great news for the 40 people of Cumbernauld that NHS

Lanarkshire is going to keep 25 beds Carrickstone Care Home. It is important that there are enough beds available for people that need them. We have been saying this throughout the review and we are pleased that it has now been confirmed. The forum is delighted at the outcome. It shows how important it is to have the public involved in the decision making process to ensure we get the right result for Cumbernauld.

Dow's Waste

The forum would like to thank the council for refusing the Dow Waste application to increase their site at Greenfaulds.

Pull out Bin Services

Residents in Westfield and Eastfield are meeting with Waste Management Service to discuss the issues with the proposed pull out service. There will be a public meeting on 26th March so residents can raise their issues around the changes to this service.

Tesco Extra

Proposed new Tesco Extra at Condorrat Social club. The forum would like to know if there has been formal planning application submitted to the council

Bus Services

The forum would like the LAP to invite First bus and SPT to a meeting to discuss bus and timetable issues in the north area.

Underpasses

Westfield to Collinwood, St Maurice's – Broadwood

Can the council please inspect these 2 underpasses as they are in a terrible condition and people are frightened to use them because the lights are broken? There are also issues with people using them as a place to drink which is causing anti social behaviour.

Pot Holes

Can we please have a report from the roads Department on when they are going to repair the pot holes across Cumbernauld as some of them are now getting to a dangerous level.

Morrisons Store

The forum would like an update on the proposed development of the Morrison's Store in Westfield

Signage for the New Recycling Facility Westfield

The Forum is pleased to see the new signage up for the Westfield Recycling Facility however could there be other signs put up from the main roundabouts to direct people to the site as this would help people coming from other areas of Cumbernauld, or Moodiesburn.
