At this point a discussion took place regarding the expenditure of the £67k, Marvyn said that he would like a detailed breakdown on how the funding was spent. 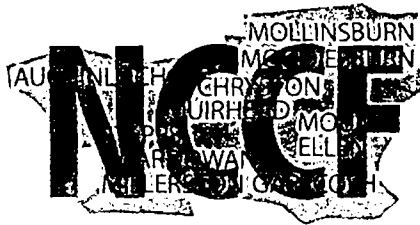
## **7. Paths and Rights of Way Project:**

Marvyn reported on the meeting in which he attended with First Bus where he advised members that he submitted general and specific comments. Rosalyn said that she is collating all the information from the meeting.

Marvyn advised members that the issues involving the 38C bus had been recognised and a new timetable has been produced.

**10. See Me Campaign:**

**11. Commonwealth Games – Glasgow 2014:**

Members discussed the Queens Baton Relay taking place on 23<sup>rd</sup> June, times and locations to be confirmed. Main activities will take place at Stepps Primary on the day of the event. Rosalyn said that the Flags and Bunting which the Forum had purchased should arrive soon. Marvyn said that he would prefer Forum members to deliver the flags and bunting to local primary schools.

Discussion also took place regarding the Cycle Time Trials taking place on 31<sup>st</sup> July and in particular the traffic management for the event. It was agreed that further information needed to be provided regarding the exact road closure times and route etc as these have not yet been finalised.

Linda advised that people will be able to get out between 7.00am and 8.30am but only at designated exit points. Letters are going out to local residents soon and there are 3 drop-in events happening across the area before then.

**12. Gala Days:**

It was noted that both the Climbing wall had been booked and that Rosalyn to confirm the booking of the Smoothie Bike. Ros said that she has arranged for information on the cycle time trial route to be given to the Forum for distribution at Moodiesburn Gala Day on 21<sup>st</sup> June.
