Fire Services Report

This was read out.

Treasurer’s Report –

It was confirmed that the Council received its annual grant from NLC. This was £801.00. It was agreed by E Smith the money held as restricted funds ((£149.74) be used to support the Sunflower event that has been running with the local primary schools since the summer. The Community Council will make up the amount to £150.00.

Cllr Goldie’s Report –

Private Landlords – There is significant work with NLC to address tenant’s issues in the area.

Footpaths – Ongoing work is continuing.

Woodlands PS – A new flashing 20 MPH sign has been erected at the school.

Cllr Homer’s Report –

Gulley – £16,000 has been awarded by NLC to allow shrubbery to be cut down (a team working for one month). Community Wardens has been working with Restorative Justice to clean up the area. The final plans will be presented to the local residents at an event. The costs are being revised downward, but the setting up of a community group is sought to allow further fundraising for the project.

Environment – Several Small Fund Community projects are to be carried out. The CCTV cameras promised have now been given locations. Scottish Water are close to allowing the housing planned in the area to go ahead.

Future Events –

The Christmas Party will be held in mid December this year. Final plans will be made soon.

Volunteers are looked for to sit on a Gala Day committee for next year.

On Wednesday 25th October there will be a joint event with the Carbrain Learning Partnership celebrating the 10th anniversary of the Community Council. We will be presenting local residents with awards to recognise their efforts in the community.
