North Locality Profile

Update on developments

1. Kilsyth Health Campus

No update from previous report.

2. Minor Injuries/Minor Illness Services – Cumbernauld Casualty Unit

The Business case has been submitted for approval to NHS Lanarkshire Capital Investment Group and work is underway to identify the potential service developments which can be delivered from the vacated space, once the X-ray department re-locates to the new building.

3. Fire at Kilsyth Health Centre – 19th February 2007-03-01

The health centre was set on fire recently and sustained significant damage to the roof space and rooms at the rear of the building.

No one was hurt during this incident.

The areas affected were mainly staff and office accommodation. The x-ray department was badly affected by smoke damage and these patients had to be directed to Central Health Centre until the department was cleared for operation. Thanks to the work of several staff groups there was minimal disruption to patients' services. Work is progressing to replace the damaged roof and refurbish the affected accommodation.
