<p>2.</p>	<p>Correspondence & Matters Arising</p> <p>Cheryl provided members with an update on a reply she received regarding No 27 Bus and Forth Hospital. On the response received it was mentioned that by re-routing the bus service it has reduced journey times. Cheryl did raise the issue regarding poor advertising and the lack of information provided regarding consultations. The reply stated that the lack of advertising will be looked at and that the company are always keen to be notified of public issues. It was also mentioned that the consultations which did take place, took place in Falkirk and not Kilsyth.</p> <p>Correspondence was received from NHS as well as all reports/minutes from NLP Board, members welcome to uplift the correspondence.</p> <p>Update provided regarding the Fifty Fifty event which took place within the @ Home centre in Airdrie, where 50 youths and 50 adults got together and shared information regarding everyday experiences etc. The event was very successful and that youths are keen to hold a similar event again.</p>
