1. Purpose of Report / Introduction

The purpose of this report is to request committee approval to declare an area of council owned land surplus to the operational requirements of Housing and Social Work Services.

2. Background

- 2.1. The site is held within the Housing Revenue Account and is considered to be surplus to operational requirements.
- 2.2. The area of land referred to in Appendix 1, Comedie Road, Stepps, extends to an area of 33m² or thereby and is not currently in productive use. A request from Regeneration & Infrastructure Services has been received to ascertain if this area could be made available for Scotland Gas Networks Ltd who require to reinforce the gas supply system. Part of the project will involve the establishment of a new District Gas Governor at Comedie Road.

3. Proposals / Considerations

3.1. It is proposed that the attached site in Appendix 1 be declared surplus to operational requirements.

4.1. There are no financial implications arising from this report

5. Recommendation

It is recommended that the Committee:

- (i) approve the proposal to declare surplus to operational requirements the area of land referred to in paragraph 3.1 and that the disposal is progressed in accordance with the Council's policy on surplus land and buildings.
