(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2007

(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Alexander Primary School, B802 Broomknoll Street, Cairnhill Road & Victoria Place, Airdrie) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007" and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty-sixth day of February, two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

SCHEDULE I

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of Road in the region of
North Lanarkshire

Alexandra Primary School

B802 Broomknoll Street, Airdrie

The length of Broomknoll Street from a point 29 metres south of the extended line of the south kerb of the A89 Weaver Road (measured along the west kerb of Broomknoll Street) southwards to where it meets Cairnhill Road, a distance of 88 metres or thereby.

B802 Cairnhill Road, Airdrie

The length of Cairnhill Road from a point 28 metres north of the extended line of the north kerb of Arthur Avenue north-westwards to where it meets Broomknoll Street (B802), a distance of 95 metres or thereby.

Victoria Place, Airdrie

The length of Victoria Place from its junction with Cairnhill Road westwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, measured along its south kerb line.
