**(St. Ambrose High School, Blair Road, Coatbridge)**

**(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St. Ambrose High School, Blair Road, Coatbridge) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007" and shall come into operation on Monday the fifteenth day of October Two Thousand and Seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule I to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the Speed Limit Signs are activated.

## SCHEDULE I

### 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

#### **St. Ambrose High School**

Blair Road, Coatbridge

The length of Blair Road from a point 23 metres north of the extended line of the north kerb of Muir Street northwards to a point 10 metres south of the extended line of the south kerb of Espieside Crescent, a distance of 257 metres or thereby.
