(SCOTT STREET & PARK STREET, MOTHERWELL) (ONE WAY) ORDER 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Scott Street and Park Street, Motherwell) (One Way) Order 2007" and shall come into operation on Tuesday, the first day of January, two thousand and eight.
- (2) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to it:-

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power".
- (3) No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the length of road in a manner other than specified in the Schedule to this Order.

ONE WAY OPERATION

Length(s) of road in the region of
North Lanarkshire

Permitted Direction of Travel

Scott Street and Park Street, Motherwell

From its junction with Dalziel Street, south-westwards then south-eastwards on Park Street to its junction with Coursington Road, a distance of 290 metres or thereby

South-westwards and
South-eastwards

4. a. Young
