**(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Langloan Primary School, Willowbank School, A89 Bank Street and Blair Road, Coatbridge) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007" and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty second of October 2007.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule I to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

SCHEDULE I

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

**Langloan Primary School and Willowbank School**

A89 Bank Street, Coatbridge

The length of A89 Bank Street from a point 94 metres south-west of the extended line of the west kerb of Kirkwood Street north-eastwards to a point 82 metres north-east of the extended line of the east kerb of Blair Road, a distance of 240 metres or thereby.

Blair Road, Coatbridge

The length of Blair Road from the extended line of the north kerb of A89 Bank Street northwards for a distance of 69 metres.
