**PROPOSED STOPPING-UP ORDER**

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a Stopping-Up Order on the lengths of the footpath from Anton Crescent to Register Road, Kilsyth from the heel of the kerb of Register Road, westwards then northwards to a point 12.5 metres south of the south kerb line of Anton Crescent, a distance of 75 metres or thereby, as shown on Drawing No HQ/TT/78/15/97/001 making it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot on the specified location.

**(STOPPING-UP) ORDER 2007**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred to them by Section 2 (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 1) This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Anton Crescent & Register Road, Kilsyth) (Stopping-Up) Order 2007" and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty-ninth day of October, Two thousand and seven.
- 2) No person shall access the footpath on Anton Crescent & Register Road, Kilsyth as specified in the Schedule to this Order.

## SCHEDULE I

### FOOTPATH TO BE STOPPED UP

Length(s) of Road in the region of North Lanarkshire

#### **Anton Crescent & Register Road, Kilsyth**

The length of the footpath from the heel of the kerb of Register Road westwards then northwards to a point 12.5 metres south of the south kerblines of Anton Crescent, for a distance of 75 metres or thereby as shown on Drawing No HQ/TT/78/15/97/001.
