(MAIN STREET AND MOTHERWELL ROAD, BELLSHILL)

PROPOSED (ONE WAY) ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to (1) revoke the County of Lanark (Motherwell Road to Crossgates, Bellshill) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1963 and re-introduce two way traffic on Crossgates, Bellshill (2) introduce a one way operation on the length of road on Main Street, Bellshill as detailed below and (3) to re-establish the one-way operation on the length of road on Motherwell Road, Bellshill as detailed below:-

	<u>Permitted Direction of Travel</u>
<u>Main Street Bellshill</u>	
From the extended line of the west kerb of Emma Jay Road westwards to the extended line of the east kerb of Hamilton Road, a distance of 348 metres or thereby.	West
<u>Motherwell Road, Bellshill</u>	
From the extended line of the south kerb of Crossgates northwestwards to its junction with Main Street, a distance of 625 metres or thereby.	Northwest

(ONE WAY) ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to 3 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street and Motherwell Road, Bellshill) (One Way) Order 2007” and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty-eighth day of January, Two thousand and eight.
2. In this Order the following expression has the meaning hereby assigned to it:- “vehicle” unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power.
3. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on Main Street and Motherwell Road, Bellshill except as specified in Schedule I to this Order.
4. The County of Lanark (Motherwell Road and Crossgates, Bellshill) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1963 is hereby revoked.

<u>Motherwell Road, Bellshill</u> From the extended line of the south kerb of Crossgates northwestwards to its junction with Main Street, a distance of 625 metres or thereby.	Northwest
