
St Timothy's and Kirkshaws Primary Schools, Old Monkland Road, Coatbridge

(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St Timothy's and Kirkshaws Primary Schools, Old Monkland Road, Coatbridge) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007" and shall come into operation on Monday, the third day of December Two Thousand and Seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The Order will only be effective when the lights are flashing on the speed limit signs.

## SCHEDULE I

### 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT


Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

St Timothy's Primary School  
Old Monkland Road, Coatbridge

From a point 101 metres east of the extended line of the west kerb of Dunblane Place eastwards to a point 20 metres East of the extended line of the east kerb of Kilmore Grove, a distance of 260 metres or thereby.

Kirkshaws Primary School  
Old Monkland Road, Coatbridge

From a point 61 metres west of the extended line of the west kerb of Rowan Place eastwards to a point 167 metres east of the extended line of the west kerb of Rowan Place, a distance of 228 metres or thereby
