MAIN STREET & WILSON COURT, BELLSHILL

PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce waiting restrictions on Main Street and Wilson Court, Bellshill as detailed below:-

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

Main Street, Bellshill

Side of road to
which restriction
applies

From a point 15 metres west of the extended line of the west kerb of Glebe Street, westwards to a point 30 metres east of the extended line of the north kerb of Locket Yett View, measured along the north kerb of Main Street, a distance of 330 metres or thereby.

Both

Wilson Court, Bellshill

From its junction with Main Street southwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby.

Both

Un-named Link Road

From its junction with Gartcosh Walk southwards to its junction with Main Street, a distance of 22 metres or thereby.

Both

As part of the proposed Order, the North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street, Bellshill) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 2003 will be revoked.

(Waiting Restrictions) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street & Wilson Court, Bellshill) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 2007" and shall come into operation on Monday, the third day of December, Two Thousand and Seven.
2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

"taxi" has the same meaning as in Section 23(1) of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982;

"Council" means the North Lanarkshire Council.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall:-
 - a) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to in that Article:-
 - A) for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage;
 - B) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of the roads so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of the roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - C) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to

the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;

D) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;

E) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Post Office and is waiting in any of the lengths of the roads while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent thereto are being unloaded from the vehicle or having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent thereto;

F) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is standing at the kerb and is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.

b) apply to a licensed taxi waiting in a taxi stance during any period for which that stance has been designated by the Council under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.

5. The North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street, Bellshill) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 2003 will be revoked as part of this Order.
