
(Golfhill Primary School, B802 Glenmavis Road and Ballochney Street, Airdrie)

(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Golfhill Primary School, B802 Glenmavis Road and Ballochney Street, Airdrie) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007" and shall come into operation on Monday, the third day of December 2007, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

North Lanarkshire


Golfhill Primary School

B802 Glenmavis Road, Airdrie

The length of B802 Glenmavis Road from a point 27 Metres northwest of the extended line of the north kerb of Dykehead Road, north-westwards for a distance of 225 metres.

Ballochney Street, Airdrie

The length of Ballochney Street from a point 84 metres northwest of the extended line of the north kerb of Lomond Drive north-westwards for a distance of 62 metres.
