**PROPOSED 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER**

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit on B753 Dundyvan Road, Coatbridge from a point 8.7 metres south-east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Mauldslie Street, south-eastwards to a point 18 metres south-east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Brown Street, a distance of 75 metres or thereby. The Speed Limit Order will only be effective when the lights are flashing on the speed limit signs.

**(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2009**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St Mary's Primary School, B753 Dundyvan Road, Coatbridge) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2009" and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty-third day of February, Two Thousand and Nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order, when the lights are flashing on the speed limit signs.

##### B753 Dundyvan Road, Coatbridge

The length of B753 Dundyvan Road, Coatbridge from a point 8.7 metres south-east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Mauldslie Street, south-eastwards to a point 18 metres south-east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Brown Street, a distance of 75 metres or thereby.
