PROPOSED 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 30 miles per hour speed limit on A71 Main Street and Overtown Road from a point 280 metres south west of the extended line of the southern kerb of B754 Castlehill Road north eastwards, for a distance of 1042 metres or thereby.

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2010

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A71 Main Street & Overtown Road, Overtown) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2010" and shall come into operation on Monday, the eighteenth day of January, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule I to this Order.
3. The Strathclyde Regional Council (Restricted Roads) (Transitional) Order 1985 is hereby amended as specified in Schedule II to this Order.

SCHEDULE I

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of Road in the region of
North Lanarkshire

A71 – Main Street & Overtown Road, Overtown

The length of the A71 Main Street and Overtown Road from a point 280 metres south west of the extended line of the southern kerb of B754 Castlehill Road north eastwards, for a distance of 1042 metres or thereby.

The Strathclyde Regional Council (Restricted Roads) (Transitional) Order 1985

The following paragraph is to be deleted from the above-named Order.

Ref L/A71-5 - That section of A71 Principal Road (Main Street) from a point 285 metres south west of the extended centre line of Castlehill Road (B754) north east to a point 667 metres north east of the projected centre line of Castlehill Road (B754). A distance of 952 metres or thereby.
