(Pollock Street & Merry Street, Motherwell)

(Prohibition of Driving) Order 2010

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Pollock Street & Merry Street, Motherwell) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2010" and shall come into operation on Monday, the fourteenth day of June, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, during the undernoted periods, with the exception of:
 - (a) Vehicles in connection with building operation, demolition, road works, utilities etc;
 - (b) Emergency service vehicles;
 - (c) Local service (bus services);
 - (d) Wedding & Funeral vehicles;
 - (e) Vehicles being used to service 1-87 Merry Street, 2/4 and 6-28 Merry Street and 1-9 Brandon Street;
 - (f) Taxi vehicles, and
 - (g) Blue badge holders
3. The Order shall only be in force every day during the period 0600 hours until 2000 hours.
4. It is considered necessary to make this Order to facilitate the passage of traffic on Pollock Street and Merry Street, Motherwell.
5. The Strathclyde Regional Council (Motherwell Town Centre) (Phase 1) (Traffic Management) Order 1989 is hereby amended as detailed in Schedule 2 of this Order.

SCHEDULE I

PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Length(s) of Road in the region of North
Lanarkshire

Pollock Street, Motherwell

From the extended line of the northern kerb of Merry Street northwards for a distance of 60 metres, or thereby.

Merry Street, Motherwell

From the extended line of the eastern kerb of Pollock Street, south westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Muir Street, a distance of 120 metres or thereby.
