PROPOSED 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 30 miles per hour speed limit on the lengths of the following road.

The proposed order will also amend the existing North Lanarkshire Council (B7066, Salsburgh) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 1997.

B7066 HIRST ROAD, SALSBURGH

The length of the B7066 Hirst Road, Salsburgh from a point 98 metres south west of the extended line of the western kerb of Kateswell Drive north eastwards to a point 253 metres west of the extended line of the western kerb of School Road, a distance of 1209 metres or thereby.

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B7066 Hirst Road, Salsburgh) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011” and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty first day of February, Two thousand and eleven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule I of this Order.
3. The North Lanarkshire Council (B7066, Salsburgh) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 1997 is hereby amended as detailed in Schedule II of this Order.
