PROPOSED 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 40 miles per hour speed limit on B758 Blantyre Farm Road, Uddingston from a point 49 metres or thereby, south west of its junction with A74 Glasgow Road, south westwards to a point 102 metres or thereby south west of its junction with the A74 Glasgow Road which point is the boundary between North Lanarkshire and South Lanarkshire, a distance of 53 metres or thereby.

(40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (B758 Blantyre Farm Road, Uddingston) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011" and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty-first day of March, Two thousand and eleven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding forty miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule I of this Order.

The length of the B758 Blantyre Farm Road, Uddingston from a point 49 metres or thereby, south west of its junction with A74 Glasgow Road, south westwards to a point 102 metres or thereby south west of its junction with the A74 Glasgow Road, the mutual boundary between North Lanarkshire and South Lanarkshire, a distance of 53 metres or thereby.
