PROPOSED 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit on the undernoted roads in the Cairnhill area of Airdrie as detailed below:-

Arthur Avenue, Airdrie over its entire length

Bellsdyke Road, Airdrie from its junction with Woodburn Avenue, south eastwards to the extended line of the north western kerb of B802 Cairnhill Road, a distance of 250 metres or thereby.

Cairn View, Airdrie over its entire length

Cairndyke Crescent, Airdrie over its entire length

Cairnhope Avenue, Airdrie over its entire length

Devonview Place, Airdrie over its entire length

Devonview Street, Airdrie from the extended line of the southern kerb of Victoria Place south eastwards and south westwards to its junction with Thomson Drive, a distance of 336 metres of thereby.

Faskine Avenue, Airdrie over its entire length

Faskine Crescent, Airdrie over its entire length

Firhill Avenue, Airdrie over its entire length

Imperial Drive, Airdrie over its entire length

Inglefield Court, Airdrie over its entire length

Parnell Street, Airdrie over its entire length

Thomson Drive, Airdrie over its entire length

Victoria Crescent, Airdrie over its entire length

Woodburn Avenue, Airdrie over its entire length

PROPOSED 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Cairnhill, Airdrie) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011” and shall come into operation on Monday, the eleventh day of April, Two thousand and eleven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule I to this Order.
