30 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Holytown) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011” and shall come into operation on Monday, the eighteenth day of April, Two thousand and eleven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule I to this Order.

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of Road in the region of
North Lanarkshire

A775 – Main Street/Edinburgh Road, Holytown

The length of the A775 Main Street/Edinburgh Road, Holytown from a point 156 metres or thereby east of the extended line of the western kerb of Melrose Avenue, eastwards to a point 183 metres or thereby west of the extended line of the western kerb of Kirk Road, Holytown, a distance of 489 metres or thereby.

A723 Carfin to Holytown Link Road, Holytown

The length of the A723 Carfin to Holytown Link Road, Holytown from the centreline of the A775 Edinburgh Road, southwards for a distance of 49 metres or thereby.

B799 Bo'ness Road, Holytown

The length of B799 Bo'ness Road from the centreline of the A775 Edinburgh Road, northwards to a point 18 metres or thereby north of the extended line of the northern kerb of Bo'ness Road, a distance of 133 metres or thereby.

The length of B799 Bo'ness Road from the centreline of the A775 Edinburgh Road, northwards to a point 18 metres or thereby north of the extended line of the northern kerb of Bo'ness Road, a distance of 133 metres or thereby.
