VARIOUS STREETS BOGSIDE, WISHAW

PROPOSED 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 30 miles per hour speed limit on the undernoted roads in the Bogside area of Wishaw as detailed below:-

Length(s) of Road in the region of North Lanarkshire	Side of Road to which restriction applies

A73 Main Street, Bogside

The length of the A73 Main Street from a point 102 metres or thereby south east of the extended line of the southern kerb of Chapel Road, south eastwards for a distance of 226 metres or thereby.

Northbound and Southbound

Circulatory carriageway of Bogside Roundabout

The length of the circulatory carriageway from its western junction with the projected centreline of A721 Wishaw Road (the boundary with South Lanarkshire Council), northwards, eastwards then southwards to its eastern junction with the projected centreline of Hyndshaw Road (the boundary with South Lanarkshire Council), a distance of 119 metres or thereby.

Both Lanes

A721 Wishaw Road, Bogside

The length of A721 Wishaw Road from a point 98 metres or thereby west of its junction with the western circulatory carriageway of Bogside Roundabout, south westwards for a distance of 222 metres or thereby.

Eastbound and Westbound

A721 Wishaw Road, Bogside

The length of the eastbound carriageway of A721 Wishaw Road from its junction with the western circulatory carriageway of Bogside Roundabout westwards for a distance of 98 metres or thereby.

Eastbound

Hyndshaw Road, Bogside

The length of the eastbound carriageway of Hyndshaw Road from its junction with the eastern circulatory carriageway of Bogside Roundabout, eastwards for a distance of 201 metres or thereby.

Eastbound

(30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Bogside, Wishaw) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011" and shall come into operation on Monday, the ninth day of January, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule I of this Order.

Northbound and Southbound

The length of the circulatory carriageway from its western junction with the projected centreline of A721 Wishaw Road (the boundary with South Lanarkshire Council), northwards, eastwards then southwards to its eastern junction with the projected centreline of Hyndshaw Road (the boundary with South Lanarkshire Council), a distance of 119 metres or thereby.

Both Lanes

A721 Wishaw Road, Bogside

The length of A721 Wishaw Road from a point 98 metres or thereby west of its junction with the western circulatory carriageway of Bogside Roundabout, south westwards for a distance of 222 metres or thereby.

Eastbound and Westbound

A721 Wishaw Road, Bogside

The length of the eastbound carriageway of A721 Wishaw Road from its junction with the western circulatory carriageway of Bogside Roundabout westwards for a distance of 98 metres or thereby.

Eastbound

Hyndshaw Road, Bogside

The length of the eastbound carriageway of Hyndshaw Road from its junction with the eastern circulatory carriageway of Bogside Roundabout, eastwards for a distance of 201 metres or thereby.
