

North Lanarkshire Council

(St Ambrose High School and Townhead Road, Coatbridge 30 MPH and Part-Time 20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2013

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St Ambrose High School and Townhead Road, Coatbridge 30 MPH and Part-Time 20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2013" and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty-eighth day of January, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. The length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
3.
 - (1) No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order, when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with sub-paragraph (2) below.
 - (2) A twenty miles per hour speed limit will apply to the length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order only when the speed limit signs are activated.
 - (3) Without prejudice to the provision of sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) above, no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

PART-TIME 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Townhead Road, Coatbridge

The length of Townhead Road from a point 210 metres or thereby north west of the extended line of the western kerb of Leven Road, south eastwards to a point 30 metres or thereby south east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Leven Road, a distance of 246 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 2

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Townhead Road, Coatbridge

The length of Townhead Road from a point 28 metres or thereby northwest of the extended line of the northwestern kerb of Lochview Road, south eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Blair Road, a distance of 1120 metres or thereby.

PROPOSED 30 MPH AND PART-TIME 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 30 miles per hour speed limit on Townhead Road from a point 28 metres or thereby north west of the extended line of the north western kerb of Lochview Road, south eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Blair Road, a distance of 1120 metres or thereby and a part time 20 miles per hour speed limit on Townhead Road, Coatbridge from a point 210 metres or thereby north west of the extended line of the western kerb of Leven Road, south eastwards to a point 30 metres or thereby south east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Leven Road, a distance of 246 metres or thereby.

The 20 miles per hour speed limit will only apply when the speed limit signs are activated.
