**40 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2013**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B717 Burnbrae Road, Shotts) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2013” and shall come into operation on Monday, the twentieth day of May, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding forty miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule I to this Order.

## **SCHEDULE I**

### **40 MPH SPEED LIMIT**

Length(s) of Road in the region of  
North Lanarkshire

#### **B717 Burnbrae Road, Shotts**

The length of Burnbrae Road, Shotts from a point 138 metres or thereby, south west of the extended line of the southern kerb of B7010 Main Street, south westwards for a distance of 733 metres or thereby.

**PROPOSED 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER**

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 40 miles per hour speed limit on Burnbrae Road, Shotts from a point 138 metres or thereby south west of the extended line of the southern kerb of B7010 Main Street, south westwards for a distance of 733 metres or thereby.
