A775 EDINBURGH ROAD, KIRK ROAD AND LEGBRANNOCK ROAD, HOLYTOWN

40 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2013

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (A775 Edinburgh Road, Kirk Road and Legbrannock Road, Holytown) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2013” and shall come into operation on Tuesday, the twenty first day of May, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding forty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule I to this Order.

SCHEDULE I

40 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of Road in the region of
North Lanarkshire

A775 Edinburgh Road

The length of Edinburgh Road from a point of 183 metres or thereby southwest of the extended line of the western kerb of Kirk Road, north eastwards to a point 45 metres or thereby northeast of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Legbrannock Road, a distance of 702 metres or thereby.

Legbrannock Road

The length of Legbrannock Road from its junction with A775 Edinburgh Road, southwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby.

Kirk Road

The length of Kirk Road from its junction with A775 Edinburgh Road, northwards to a point 19 metres or thereby south of the extended line of the southern kerb of Legbrannock Avenue, a distance of 20 metres or thereby.

PROPOSED 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 40 miles per hour speed limit on the undernoted roads in Holytown, as detailed below:-

A775 Edinburgh Road

The length of the A775 Edinburgh Road from a point 183 metres southwest of the extended line of the western kerb of Kirk Road, north eastwards to a point 45 metres northeast of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Legbrannock Road, a distance of 702 metres or thereby.

Legbrannock Road

The length of Legbrannock Road from its junction with A775 Edinburgh Road, southwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby.

Kirk Road

The length of Kirk Road from its junction with A775 Edinburgh Road, northwards to a point 19 metres south of the extended line of the southern kerb of Legbrannock Avenue, a distance of 20 metres or thereby.
