#### **STOPPING UP ORDER 2013**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred to them by Section 68 (1) (b) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having considered that the road specified in the Schedule to this Order had become unnecessary and being satisfied that no alternative road was necessary, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1) This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (David Street, Salsburgh) (Stopping Up) Order 2013 and shall come into operation on Monday, the ninth day of September, Two thousand and thirteen.
- 2) The stopping up of the road in Salsburgh specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby ordered.
- 3) Where there is, immediately before the date on which the length of David Street, Salsburgh, as specified in the Schedule, is stopped up under this Order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across the length of the carriageway for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the said statutory undertakers shall, after commencement of this Order, continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.

## SCHEDULE

### LENGTH OF CARRIAGEWAY TO BE STOPPED UP

Length(s) of carriageway in the region of North Lanarkshire

#### **David Street, Salsburgh**

The length of carriageway of David Street, Salsburgh, from its junction with Muirhall Terrace, north westwards to a point 24 metres or thereby south east of its junction with Main Street, a distance of 38 metres or thereby.
