PROPOSED 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER

The North Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 30 miles per hour speed limit on B802 Glenmavis Road, Glenmavis, Airdrie from its junction with B803 Coatbridge Road, south eastwards to a point 28 metres or thereby south east of the extended line of the south eastern kerb of Woodhead Crescent, a distance of 228 metres or thereby.

(30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2013

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (B802 Glenmavis Road, Glenmavis, Airdrie) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order" and shall come into operation on Monday, the fourth day of November, Two thousand and thirteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

B802 Glenmavis Road, Glenmavis

The length of B802 Glenmavis Road, Glenmavis from its junction with B803 Coatbridge Road, south eastwards to a point 28 metres or thereby south east of the extended line of the south eastern kerb of Woodhead Crescent, a distance of 228 metres or thereby.
