St Edwards and Tollbrae Primary Schools, A73 Motherwell Street and A73 Carlisle Road, Airdrie

30 MPH and Part Time 20 MPH Speed Limit Order 2014

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St Edwards and Tollbrae Primary Schools, A73 Motherwell Street and A73 Carlisle Road, Airdrie) 30 MPH and Part Time 20 MPH Speed Limit Order 2014" and shall come into operation on Monday, the eighth day of September, Two thousand and fourteen.
2. The length of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order shall cease to be restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 3
 - (1) No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order, when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with sub-paragraph (2) below.
 - (2) A twenty miles per hour speed limit will apply to the length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order, only when the speed limit signs are activated.
 - (3) Without prejudice to the provision of sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) above, no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the length of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- (4) The Strathclyde Regional Council (Restricted Roads) (Transitional) Order 1985 is hereby amended as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

A73 Motherwell Street and A73 Carlisle Road, Airdrie

From a point on A73 Motherwell Street, 47 metres or thereby, south of the extended line of the southern kerb of Dykehead Road, south eastwards to a point on A73 Carlisle Road, 234 metres or thereby, south of the extended line of the southern kerb of Craigneuk Avenue, a distance of 2,600 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 2

PART TIME 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

A73 Carlisle Road, Airdrie

From a point 142 metres or thereby, south of the extended line of the southern kerb of A89 Forrest Street, southwards for a distance of 123 metres or thereby.

That length of A73 (Motherwell Street, Carlisle Road) from a point 50m south of the centre line of the east leg of Dykhead Road, Airdrie southwards to a point 234m south of the south kerblines of Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie. A distance of 2600m or thereby.
