**Un-named footpath between Hillcrest Court and Beechwood Road
below North Carbrain Road, Cumbernauld**

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2006

On 5 April 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of persons engaged on renovation works) on the approach ramps and un-named footpath leading from Hillcrest Court westwards under North Carbrain Road to Beechwood Road by reason of works proposed to be executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the west side of the closure should proceed via either of the adjacent underpasses situated to the north-east and south-west of the closure.

Pedestrians on the east side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0900 hours on Monday, 17 April 2006 and will remain in operation until 1700 hours on Sunday, 7 May 2006.

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Un-named footpath between Hillcrest Court and Beechwood Road below North Carbrain Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0900 hours on Monday, the seventeenth day of April, Two thousand and six until 1700 hours on Sunday, the seventh day of May, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on renovation works) on the approach ramps and un-named footpath leading from Hillcrest Court westwards under North Carbrain Road to Beechwood Road by reason of works proposed to be executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the west side of the closure should proceed via either of the adjacent underpasses situated to the north-east and south-west of the closure.

Pedestrians on the east side of the closure to proceed vice versa.
