A8011 Glasgow Road and B8054 Jane's Brae, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On Wednesday 17 May 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on the undernoted locations by reason of works proposed to be executed on or near that location.

Extent of closure

A8011, Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (Northbound)

The A8011, Glasgow Road (northbound) from the start of the unnamed off-slip road (A8011, Glasgow Road (northbound) to Seafar Roundabout) to its junction with the Town Centre West Roundabout.

A8011, Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (Southbound)

The A8011, Glasgow Road (southbound) from its junction with the Town Centre West Roundabout to the end of the unnamed on-slip road (B8039 Jane's Brae (westbound) to A8011 Glasgow Road (southbound)).

B8039 Jane's Brae (Westbound)

The B8039 Jane's Brae (westbound) from the start of the unnamed on-slip road (B8039 Jane's Brae (westbound) to A8011 Glasgow Road (northbound) to its junction with the A8011 Glasgow Road (northbound).

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure to proceed north eastwards on the unnamed off-slip road (A8011 Glasgow Road, northbound – Seafar Roundabout) to Seafar Roundabout, exit on Seafar Road and proceed northwards and north eastwards on Seafar Road to Braehead Roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit on the unnamed on-slip road (Braehead Roundabout – A8011 Wilderness Brae), then proceed south westwards on A8011 Central Way to the Town Centre West Roundabout.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

Vehicles wishing to travel on B8039 Jane's Brae to follow the alternative route to Braehead Roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit on the unnamed on-slip road (Braehead Roundabout – B8054 Lye Brae), proceed south eastwards on B8054 Lye Brae, south westwards on B8054 Lenziemill Road then westwards on B8039 Jane's Brae.

Vehicles on Jane's Brae to proceed vice versa.

The Order, which will only be effective between the hours of 2000 on Fridays to 0600 on Mondays and when 'road closed' signing and barriers are erected at the start point for the closure, will come into operation at 2000 hours on Friday 2 June 2006 and will remain in operation until 0600 hours on Monday 12 June 2006.

A8011 Glasgow Road and B8054 Jane's Brae, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A8011 Glasgow Road and B8054 Jane's Brae, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006" and shall be effective during the period from 2000 hours on Friday, the second day of June, Two thousand and six until 0600 hours on Monday, the twelfth day of June, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on the undernoted locations by reason of works proposed to be executed on or near that location.

Extent of closure

A8011, Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (Northbound)

The A8011, Glasgow Road (northbound) from the start of the unnamed off-slip road (A8011, Glasgow Road (northbound) to Seafar Roundabout) to its junction with the Town Centre West Roundabout.

A8011, Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (Southbound)

The A8011, Glasgow Road (southbound) from its junction with the Town Centre West Roundabout to the end of the unnamed on-slip road (B8039 Jane's Brae (westbound) to A8011 Glasgow Road (southbound)).

B8039 Jane's Brae (Westbound)

The B8039 Jane's Brae (westbound) from the start of the unnamed on-slip road (B8039 Jane's Brae (westbound) to A8011 Glasgow Road (northbound) to its junction with the A8011 Glasgow Road (northbound).

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure to proceed north eastwards on the unnamed off-slip road (A8011 Glasgow Road, northbound – Seafar Roundabout) to Seafar Roundabout, exit on Seafar Road and proceed northwards and north eastwards on Seafar Road to Braehead Roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit on the unnamed on-slip road (Braehead Roundabout – A8011 Wilderness Brae), then proceed south westwards on A8011 Central Way to the Town Centre West Roundabout.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

Vehicles wishing to travel on B8039 Jane's Brae to follow the alternative route to Braehead Roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit on the unnamed on-slip road (Braehead Roundabout – B8054 Lye Brae), proceed south eastwards on B8054 Lye Brae, south westwards on B8054 Lenziemill Road then westwards on B8039 Jane's Brae.

Vehicles on Jane's Brae to proceed vice versa.
