Beechwood Crescent and Hawthorn Drive, Wishaw

(Temporary Road Closures) Order 2006

On 10 May 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main renewal works) on the undernoted locations by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Closure 1

Beechwood Crescent, Wishaw from its junction with Campbell Street to the extended line of the north kerb of Knowehead Road.

Alternative Routes:

Vehicles travelling northwestwards on Campbell Street wishing to gain access to Beechwood Crescent should proceed northwestwards on Campbell Street, northeastwards on Hawthorn Drive and southeastwards on The Roundel to Beechwood Crescent.

Vehicles travelling southeastwards on Campbell Street wishing to gain access to Beechwood Crescent should proceed southeastwards on Campbell Street, northeastwards on Greenhead Road to Beechwood Crescent.

Vehicles on Beechwood Crescent wishing to gain access to Campbell Street should proceed northwestwards on The Roundel, southwestwards on Hawthorn Drive to Campbell Street.

Vehicular access to dwellings on Beechwood Crescent and Knowehead Road will be by arrangement with the Contractor and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Closure 2

Hawthorn Drive, Wishaw from its junction with Campbell Street to the extended line of the northeast kerb with The Roundel.

Alternative routes:

Vehicles travelling northwestwards on Campbell Street wishing to gain access to Curlinghaugh Crescent should proceed northwestwards on Campbell Street, northeastwards on Kirk Road and southeastwards on Meadowburn Road to Hawthorn Drive.

Vehicles travelling northwestwards on Campbell Street wishing to gain access to Hawthorn Drive should proceed northwestwards on Campbell Street, northeastwards on Kirk Road and southeastwards on Meadowburn Road to the northeast side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling southeastwards on Campbell Street wishing to gain access to Hawthorn Drive should proceed southeastwards on Campbell Street, northeastwards on Greenhead Road to Hawthorn Drive.

Vehicles travelling southeastwards on Campbell Street wishing to gain access to The Roundel should proceed southeastwards on Campbell Street and northeastwards on Greenhead Road to The Roundel..

Vehicles on Curlinghaugh Crescent wishing to gain access to Hawthorn Drive should proceed northwards on Curlinghaugh Crescent and southeastwards on Meadowburn Road to the northeast side of the closure.

Vehicles on Curlinghaugh Crescent wishing to gain access to The Roundel should proceed northwards on Curlinghaugh Crescent, southeastwards on Meadowburn Road, northeastwards then southeastwards on Hawthorn Drive, and southwestwards on Greenhead Road to The Roundel.

Vehicles on Curlinghaugh Crescent wishing to gain access to Campbell Street via Hawthorn Drive should proceed northwards on Curlinghaugh Crescent, northwestwards on Meadowburn Road, southwestwards on Kirk Road to Campbell Street.

Vehicles on The Roundel wishing to gain access to Campbell Street via Hawthorn Drive should proceed southwestwards on Beechwood Crescent to Campbell Street.

Vehicles on The Roundel wishing to gain access to Curlinghaugh Crescent should proceed southwestwards on Beechwood Crescent, northwestwards on Campbell Street, northeastwards on Kirk Road and southeastwards on Meadowburn Road to Curlinghaugh Crescent.

Vehicles on The Roundel wishing to gain access to Hawthorn Drive should proceed eastwards on Beechwood Crescent and northeastwards on Greenhead Road to Beechwood Crescent.

Vehicles on Hawthorn Drive wishing to gain access to The Roundel should proceed northeastwards then southeastwards on Hawthorn Drive, southwestwards on Greenhead Road to The Roundel.

Vehicles on Hawthorn Drive wishing to gain access to Curlinghaugh Crescent should proceed northeastwards on Hawthorn Drive and northwestwards on Meadowburn Road to Curlinghaugh Crescent.

Vehicles on Hawthorn Drive wishing to gain access to Campbell Street should proceed northeastwards then southeastwards on Hawthorn Drive, southwestwards on Greenhead Road to Campbell Street.

Vehicular access to dwellings on Hawthorn Drive will be by arrangement with the Contractor and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The appropriate diversion signing will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during each closure associated with the works. Each closure will only be valid when the appropriate signing is in place. The closures shall not take place at the same time and it is anticipated that the works shall be completed within 12 weeks.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 22 May 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 3 September 2006.

(Temporary Road Closures) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Beechwood Crescent and Hawthorn Drive, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closures) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty second of May, Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Sunday, the third day of September, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main renewal works) on the undernoted locations by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Closure 1

Beechwood Crescent, Wishaw from its junction with Campbell Street to the extended line of the north kerb of Knowehead Road.

Closure 2

Hawthorn Drive, Wishaw from its junction with Campbell Street to the extended line of the northeast kerb with The Roundel.
