(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On 24 May 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) over the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Kennedy Drive, Airdrie (from the extended line of the east kerb of Martyn Street to its junction with Craig Street)

Cairnhill Avenue, Airdrie (entire length)

Woodview Drive, Airdrie (entire length)

Whinhall Road, Airdrie (from its junction with Wilson Street to its junction with Burnfoot Road)

Progress Drive, Caldercruix (from the extended line of the east kerb of Dunbreck Avenue to its junction with Moss Avenue)

Drumfin Avenue, Caldercruix (entire length)

Park Lea, Caldercruix (entire length)

Woodside Road and Forrestfield Road, Caldercruix (entire length)

Crathie Drive, Glenmavis (from the extended line of the east kerb of Hawkwood Road to its junction with Dunnet Avenue)

Agnew Avenue, Coatbridge – service road (from its junction with Agnew Avenue adjacent to No 20 to its junction with Agnew Avenue adjacent to No 46)

Corsewall Street, Coatbridge (from its junction with Blairhill Road to the extended line of the west kerb of Montgomery Avenue)

Huntly Drive, Coatbridge (entire length)

Dunbar Avenue, Coatbridge (entire length)

Coathill Street, Coatbridge (entire length)

Meadow Street, Coatbridge (entire length)

Hospital Street, Coatbridge (from its junction with School Street to the extended line of the west kerb of Margaret Street)

Wallace Street, Coatbridge (entire length)

Hillcrest Avenue, Coatbridge (entire length)

Kildonan Street, Coatbridge – service road (from its junction with Crown Street to its junction with Kildonan Street)

Riddell Street, Coatbridge (entire length)

Yetts Hole Road, Coatbridge (from the extended line of the north kerb of Mollinsburn Road to its junction with Gain and Shankburn Road)

The works will be carried out as part of a rolling programme.

Alternative routes will be signposted for each closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Access to properties affected by these works will be maintained where practicable by arrangement with the contractor.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 5 June 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Saturday, 30 September 2006.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Central Area) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday the fifth day of June Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Saturday the thirtieth day of September Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) over the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.
