(Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 2006

On 7 June 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to undertake a right hand manoeuvre from B802 Bank Street into Hallcraig Street, Airdrie (with the exception of vehicles engaged on town centre improvement works) by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling northwards on Bank Street requiring to turn right into Hallcraig Street should proceed north-westwards on the B802 South Bridge Street, north-eastwards on A8010 High Street continuing onto Chapel Street, south-eastwards on the B8052 Bore Road, then westwards on Flowerhill Street continuing westwards to gain access to Hallcraig Street.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 19 June 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 16 July 2006.

(Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Bank Street/Hallcraig Street, Airdrie) (Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the nineteenth day of June, Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Sunday, the sixteenth day of July, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall undertake a right hand manoeuvre from B802 Bank Street into Hallcraig Street, Airdrie (with the exception of vehicles engaged on town centre improvement works) by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling northwards on Bank Street requiring to turn right into Hallcraig Street should proceed north-westwards on the B802 South Bridge Street, north-eastwards on A8010 High Street continuing onto Chapel Street, south-eastwards on the B8052 Bore Road, then westwards on Flowerhill Street continuing westwards to gain access to Hallcraig Street.
