(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On 21 June 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on town centre improvement works) on the B802 Bank Street, Airdrie from its junction with Stirling Street to its junction with Hallcraig Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed southwards on Broomknoll Street, proceed around the roundabout and exit eastwards on the A89 Weavers Road, proceed around the roundabout and exit northwards on Gartlea Road, proceed around the roundabout and exit northwards on Baillies Lane, then proceed westwards on Hallcraig Street to the north side of the closure.

The Order, which will only be effective between the hours of 0001 on Saturdays to 2359 hours on Sundays and when sign posted, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 8 July 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 13 August 2006.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which will only be effective between the hours of 0001 on Saturdays to 2359 hours on Sundays and when sign posted, may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B802 Bank Street, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the eighth day of July, Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Sunday, the thirteenth day of August, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on town centre improvement works) on the B802 Bank Street, Airdrie from its junction with Stirling Street to its junction with Hallcraig Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed southwards on Broomknoll Street, proceed around the roundabout and exit eastwards on the A89 Weavers Road, proceed around the roundabout and exit northwards on Gartlea Road, proceed around the roundabout and exit northwards on Baillies Lane, then proceed westwards on Hallcraig Street to the north side of the closure.
