Various Roads, Cumbernauld, Kilsyth, Moodiesburn and Stepps

(Temporary Road Closures) Order 2006

On 21 June 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

The appropriate diversion signing will be placed advising drivers of the restrictions during each closure associated with the resurfacing works. Each closure will last up to 14 days and no two closures will take place at any one time.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Location One

Craigelvan Place, Condorrat, Cumbernauld over its entire length.

There is no alternative route

Location Two

Barbeth Road, Condorrat, Cumbernauld from the extended line of the kerb of Barbeth Way westwards to the end of the road.

There is no alternative route

Location Three

Barbeth Way, Condorrat, Cumbernauld over its entire length.

There is no alternative route

Location Four

Garbethill Road, Cumbernauld from the extended line of the south-east side of the Easter Fannyside Farm building to the extended line of the west kerb of Arns Road.

Alternative Route: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed south-westwards, southwards then south-westwards on Garbethill Road, north-westwards on Fannyside Road, north-eastwards on Forest Road and eastwards and south-eastwards on Arns Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

Location Five

Arns Road, Cumbernauld over its entire length

Alternative Route: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Forest Road, south-eastwards on Fannyside Road, north-eastwards, northwards then north-eastwards on Garbethill Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

Location Six

Torbrex Road, North Carbrain, Cumbernauld over its entire length.

There is no alternative route.

Location Seven

Moss Knowe, Kildrum, Cumbernauld over its entire length.

There is no alternative route.

Location Eight

Doonside, Kildrum, Cumbernauld over its entire length.

There is no alternative route.

Location Nine

Carrick Road, Village, Cumbernauld over its entire length.

There is no alternative route.

Location 10

The Auld Road, Village, Cumbernauld from the extended line of the north kerb of Carrick Road south-westwards to the end of the road.

There is no alternative route.

Location 11

The entire Blenheim Avenue Car Park, Stepps

Location 12

Old Gartloch Road, Gartcosh from its junction with A752 westwards to the end of the road.

There is no alternative route.

Location 13

Avenuehead Road, Moodiesburn over its entire length.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road, then south-westwards on A752 Cumbernauld Road, southwards on A752 Station Road, eastwards and north-eastwards on A752 Drumcavel Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 14

Manse Road, Kilsyth from its junction with the B802 Howe Road for a distance of 250 metres or thereby.

Edmonstone Drive, Kilsyth from its junction with Manse Road northwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the west side of the closure to proceed northwards on B802 Howe Road, eastwards on U.P. Road, south-eastwards on Low Craigends and westwards on Manse Road to east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 15

Victoria Crescent, Kilsyth over its entire length.

There is no alternative route.

Location 16

Tak-ma-doon Road, Kilsyth from the extended line of the north side of the access road to Berryhill Farm to the North Lanarkshire Council boundary at Carron Bridge.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on Tak-ma-doon Road, eastwards on the B818, south-eastwards and southwards on the A872 Nethermains Road, southwards on A872 Denny Road, south-eastwards on Glasgow Road, eastwards on A803 Kilsyth Road then follow onto Stirling Road northwards and north-eastwards on Tak-ma-doon Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

Location 17

Balcastle Road, Kilsyth from the extended line of the east kerb of Dykehead Road to its junction with Glasgow Road.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed southwards on Dykehead Road and Mill Road and north-eastwards on A803 Glasgow Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

Location 18

High Banton Road, Banton over its entire length.

There is no alternative route.

The Order, will come into operation at 0915 hours on Tuesday, 4 July 2006 and will remain in operation until 1700 hours on Saturday, 30 September 2006.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Roads, Cumbernauld, Kilsyth, Moodiesburn & Stepps) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0915 hours on Tuesday, the fourth day of July, Two thousand and six until 1700 hours on Saturday, the thirtieth day of September, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

The appropriate diversion signing will be placed advising drivers of the restrictions during each closure associated with the resurfacing works. Each closure will last up to 14 days and no two closures will take place at any one time.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

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Location Four

Garbethill Road, Cumbernauld from the extended line of the south-east side of the Easter Fannyside Farm building to the extended line of the west kerb of Arns Road.

Alternative Route: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed south-westwards, southwards then south-westwards on Garbethill Road, north-westwards on Fannyside Road, north-eastwards on Forest Road and eastwards and south-eastwards on Arns Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

Location Five

Arns Road, Cumbernauld over its entire length

Alternative Route: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Forest Road, south-eastwards on Fannyside Road, north-eastwards, northwards then north-eastwards on Garbethill Road to the south side of the closure.

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There is no alternative route.

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The entire Blenheim Avenue Car Park, Stepps

Location 12

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There is no alternative route.

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Avenuehead Road, Moodiesburn over its entire length.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road, then south-westwards on A752 Cumbernauld Road, southwards on A752 Station Road, eastwards and north-eastwards on A752 Drumcavel Road to the south side of the closure.

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Alternative route: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on Tak-ma-doon Road, eastwards on the B818, south-eastwards and southwards on the A872 Nethermains Road, southwards on A872 Denny Road, south-eastwards on Glasgow Road, eastwards on A803 Kilsyth Road then follow onto Stirling Road northwards and north-eastwards on Tak-ma-doon Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

Location 17

Balcastle Road, Kilsyth from the extended line of the east kerb of Dykehead Road to its junction with Glasgow Road.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed southwards on Dykehead Road and Mill Road and north-eastwards on A803 Glasgow Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure to proceed vice versa.

Location 18

High Banton Road, Banton over its entire length.

There is no alternative route.
