(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On 21 June 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage works) on Easter Road, Shotts from its junction with Shottskirk Road for its entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

There is no alternative route.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 3 July 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 27 August 2006.

Vehicular access to properties on Easter Road, Union Street and John Smith Way to be maintained on arrangement with the contractor. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Easter Road, Shotts) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the third day of July, Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Sunday, twenty-seventh day of August, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage works) on Easter Road, Shotts from its junction with Shottskirk Road for its entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.
