Various Roads, Holytown

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, made the above-named Order to be observed by vehicles (with the exception of vehicles connected with the parade by the County Grand Lodge of the Orange Order) on the undernoted roads on Saturday, 8 July 2006.

Roads to be Closed to all Vehicles:-

Kirk Road, Newhouse over its entire length.

A775 Edinburgh Road, Newhouse from the extended line of the western kerb of Legbrannock Road south westwards to its junction with the A775 Edinburgh Road/B799 Bo'ness Road roundabout.

A775 Edinburgh Road/B799 Bo'ness Road roundabout in its entirety.

A775 Main Street, Holytown from its junction with the A775 Edinburgh Road/B799 Bo'ness Road roundabout southwestwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Stevenston Street.

B799 Stevenston Street, Holytown and New Stevenston over its entire length.

Jerviston Street, New Stevenston from its junction with B799 Stevenston Street southwards, then south eastwards, and northwards to its junction with Quarry Street.

Quarry Street, New Stevenston from its junction with Jerviston Street northwestwards and northwards to its junction with Shirrel Road.

Shirrel Road, Holytown over its entire length.

Dornoch Road, Holytown from its junction with Shirrel Road northwards, then northeastwards to its junction with Sunnyside Crescent.

The above closures will be implemented by the presence of a Police Constable as and when required, during the period between 1000 hours and 1800 hours on Saturday, 8 July 2006 (or until the parade is completed, whichever is the lesser).

Alternative Routes:-

Traffic on the western side of the closure wishing to travel northeastwards on the A775 through Holytown should proceed westwards on Holytown Road, southwards on B7029 Calder Road, eastwards on B7029 Clydesdale Road, south-westwards on Clydesdale Street/Carfin Street, then southwards on A723, eastwards, then north-eastwards and northwards on B7066 Motherwell Road/Newarthill Road/Carfin Road/High Street and northwards on A73 Carlisle Road to A775 Edinburgh Road.

Traffic on the eastern side of the closure wishing to travel westwards on the A775 through Holytown should proceed vice versa.

Traffic on B799 Bo'ness Road wishing to travel to the A723 should proceed northeastwards, then south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Lancaster Avenue, then south-westwards and southwards on the A73, southwards and southwestwards on B7066 High Street/Carfin Road/Newarthill Road/Motherwell Road to the A723.

Traffic on the A723 wishing to travel to the B799 Bo'ness Road should proceed vice versa.

Traffic on the western side of the closure wishing to travel northeastwards on the B799 should proceed westwards on Holytown Road, southwards on B7029 Calder Road, eastwards on B7029 Clydesdale Road, south-eastwards on Clydesdale Street/Carfin Street, then southwards on the A723, eastwards, then north-eastwards and northwards on B7066 Motherwell Road/Newarthill Road/Carfin Road/High Street, northwards and north-westwards on A73 and southwestwards, west and north-westwards on Lancaster Avenue to the B799.

Traffic on the B799 side of the closure wishing to travel to the western side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Traffic on the western side of the closure wishing to travel southwards on the A723 should proceed westwards on Holytown Road, southwards on B7029 Calder Road, eastwards on B7029 Clydesdale Road, south-westwards on Clydesdale Street/Carfin Street to the A723.

Traffic on the A723 side of the closure wishing to travel to the western side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Traffic on the A723 side of the closure wishing to travel northeastwards on the A775 to proceed south-west on the A723, northeastwards and northwards on the B7066 Motherwell Road/Newarthill Road/Carfin Road/High Street and northwards on the A73 to the A775.

Traffic on the eastern side of the closure wishing to travel to the A723 should proceed vice versa.

Traffic on the eastern side of the closure wishing to travel to the B799 should proceed northeastwards on the A775, north and north-westwards on the A73, south-westwards, westwards and north-westwards on Lancaster Avenue to the B799.

Traffic on the B799 side of the closure wishing to travel to the eastern side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Classes of Vehicle Prohibited

All, apart from those vehicles involved in the organisation of the parade.

Note

Limited local vehicular access to/from St. Andrews Street and Melrose Avenue, Holytown will be maintained during the parade, with Strathclyde Police allowing those vehicles to travel eastwards on A775 Main Street. Strathclyde Police will then direct parade and vehicular traffic at the above junctions.

The private access road from the Keir Hardie Sports Centre

Prohibition of Left Turns onto A775 Main Street, Holytown

Stewart Quadrant, Holytown
Melrose Avenue, Holytown
St. Andrews Street, Holytown
Alexandria Quadrant, Holytown

No Waiting and No Loading Restrictions 0700 hours to 1900 hours

A775 Main Street, Holytown, both sides of the road from its junction with Edinburgh Road/B799 Bo'ness Road roundabout, southwestwards to the extended line of the western kerb of B799 Stevenston Street.

Quarry Street/Loanhead Road, New Stevenston, both sides of the road from its junction with Shirrel Road southwards and south eastwards to its junction with Carfin to Holytown Road roundabout.

The above waiting restrictions will only be effective when Police No Waiting Cones are in place during the period between 0700 hours and 1900 hours on Saturday, 8 July 2006.

The Order will come into operation at 0700 hours until 1900 hours on Saturday, 8 July 2006.

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Roads, Holytown) (Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2006" and shall be effective during Saturday 8 July Two thousand and six from 0700 hours until 1900 hours.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles connected with the parade by the County Grand Lodge of the Orange Order) on the undernoted roads on Saturday, 8 July 2006.

Roads to be Closed to all Vehicles:-

Kirk Road, Newhouse over its entire length.

A775 Edinburgh Road, Newhouse from the extended line of the western kerb of Legbrannock Road south westwards to its junction with the A775 Edinburgh Road/B799 Bo'ness Road roundabout.

A775 Edinburgh Road/B799 Bo'ness Road roundabout in its entirety.

A775 Main Street, Holytown from its junction with the A775 Edinburgh Road/B799 Bo'ness Road roundabout southwestwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Stevenston Street.

B799 Stevenston Street, Holytown and New Stevenston over its entire length.

Jerviston Street, New Stevenston from its junction with B799 Stevenston Street southwards, then south eastwards, and northwards to its junction with Quarry Street.

Quarry Street, New Stevenston from its junction with Jerviston Street northwestwards and northwards to its junction with Shirrel Road.

Shirrel Road, Holytown over its entire length.

Dornoch Road, Holytown from its junction with Shirrel Road northwards, then northeastwards to its junction with Sunnyside Crescent.

The above closures will be implemented by the presence of a Police Constable as and when required, during the period between 0700 hours and 1900 hours on Saturday, 8 July 2006 (or until the parade is completed, whichever is the lesser).

Classes of Vehicle Prohibited

All, apart from those vehicles involved in the organisation of the parade.

Quarry Street/Loanhead Road, New Stevenston, both sides of the road from its junction with Shirrel Road southwards and south eastwards to its junction with Carfin to Holytown Road roundabout.

The above waiting restrictions will only be effective when Police No Waiting Cones are in place during the period between 0700 hours and 1900 hours on Saturday, 8 July 2006.
